## The Prep

Download our app

Arrive Early

Have your boarding pass ready

## The Bins



(if your boarding pass is on your cell phone, place it in your bag after it is scanned.)

### Place these items in the bin:

#### Outerwear

Remove bulky sweaters and winter coats.

#### Laptop computer

Unpack it from its case.

### Keep in your carry-on:

#### Metal items

Coins, keys, watches and jewellery.

#### Small electronics

Smartphone, tablet, e-reader and camera.

### Liquids, aerosols and gels

Place your **1 L plastic bag** of liquids, aerosols and gels in the bin.

### Exempted liquids and medicine

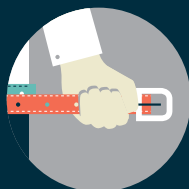
#### Medications, baby formula, breast milk

Be prepared to show them to the screening officer.

## The Metal Detector



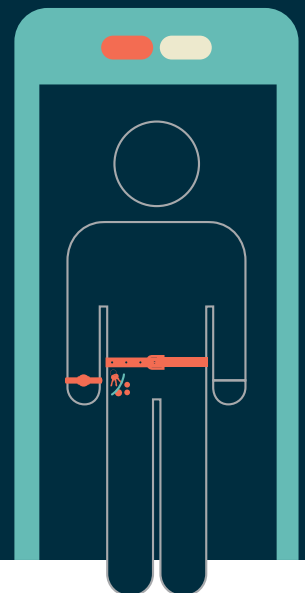
**Metal items** (coins, keys and even gum wrappers) **can set off the detector**. Put them in your carry-on bag.



You **may be asked** to unbuckle your **belt** and hold out the ends to either side for the screening officer to inspect.



You **may be asked** to remove your **footwear**. Some – like construction boots and high-heeled shoes – can contain metal shanks.
