## Screening Officer Performance Event Management System (PEMS) Privacy Impact Assessment

This is a summary of the Privacy Impact Assessment (PIA) completed by the Canadian Air Transport Security Authority (CATSA) for the Performance Event Management System (PEMS) project. The PIA was conducted using the Treasury Board of Canada Secretariat guidelines for conducting PIAs, which incorporates the ten principles of the Canadian Standards Association (CSA) Model Code for assessing fair information handling practices.

Section 6 of the CATSA Act sets out CATSA's mandate and provides that CATSA is to "take actions, either directly or through a Screening Contractor, for the effective and efficient screening of persons who access aircraft or restricted areas through screening points, the property in their possession or control and the belongings or baggage that they give to an air carrier for transport". CATSA is responsible for ensuring consistency in the delivery of screening across Canada. PEMS is a webbased system to ensure that all Performance Events are appropriately reviewed and addressed in a timely manner.

This proposal relates to the CATSA institution-specific Personal Information Bank: Learning Management CATSA PPU 950. The PIB will require minor updates in response to the privacy analysis.
